The Call is addressed to emerging and professional actresses and actors, especially with migrant background, living in Italy, Poland, Spain and other European countries, for the participation in the project international performance, entitled *Antigone's Cantica*, that will be produced during the project.

The project envisages the implementation of three Eco-Arts Residences in three natural parks in Spain, in Poland and in Italy. The theatrical ecology activity in the parks will be connected with the research and experimentation of new forms of site-specific performances in the nature and the realization of the international multilingual performance *Antigone's Cantica*.

The selected artists will participate in the performance preparation and presentation that will be made during the three International Artistic Residences held in 2023 in Spain (second half of April), Poland (first half of June) and Italy (first half of July).
